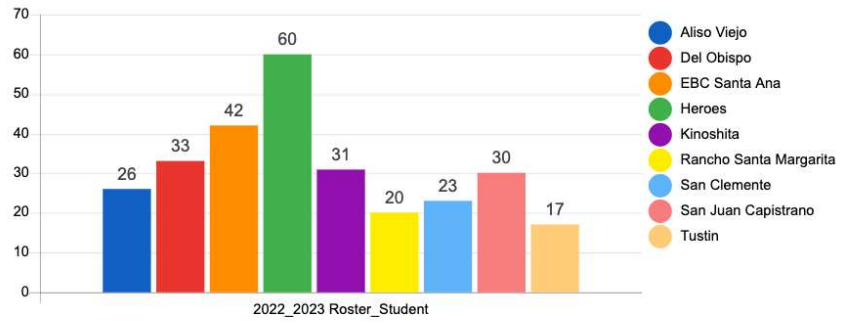

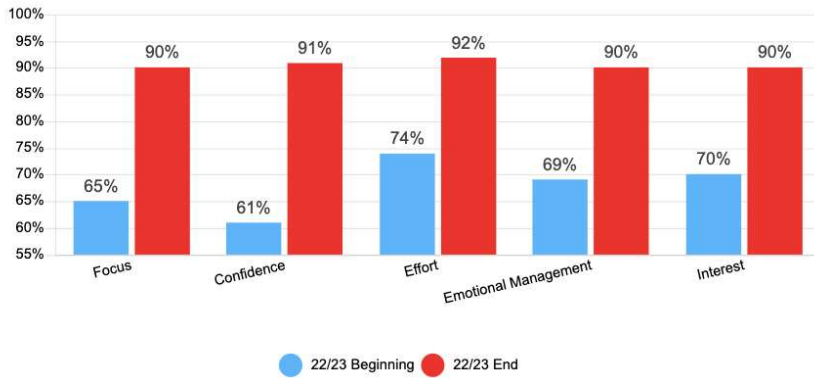

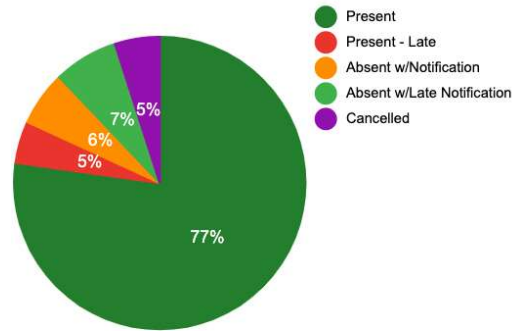

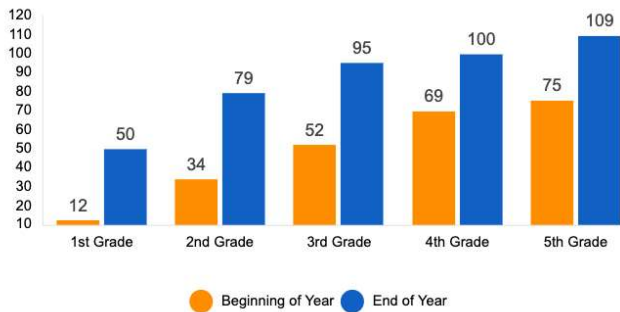
Social Emotional Learning (12+ Sessions)



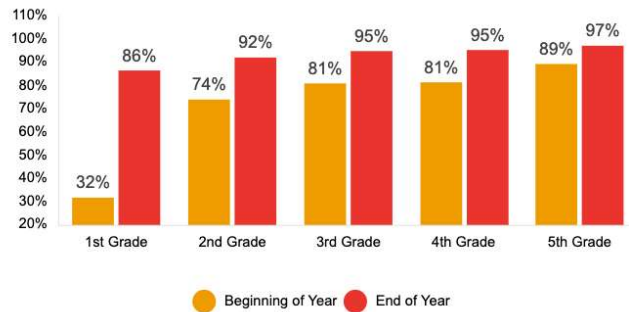
Session Attendance Summary (2022-2023)



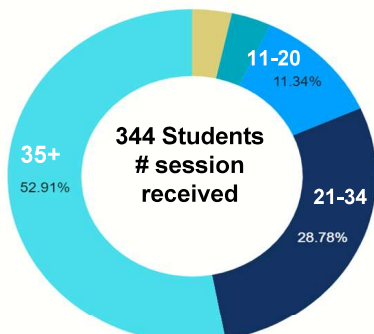
2022 - 2023 Words per Minute Overall Growth
